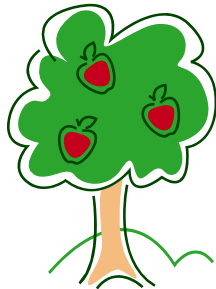
September Songs and Fingerplays!
