Day 1

1 Chronicles 29:13

"Now, our God, we give you thanks, and praise your glorious name."

What can you give God thanks for right now and how can you praise His name?



Day 2

1 Thessalonians 1:2

"We always thank God for all of you, mentioning you in our prayers."

Who can you pray for right now, mentioning them in your prayers?



Day 3

Psalms 147:7

"Sing to the LORD with thanksgiving; make music to our God on the harp."

Think of a song we can sing with thankful hearts. Let's sing it right now!



Day 4

Psalms 118:28

"You are my God, and I will give you thanks; you are my God, and I will exalt you."

What does it mean to exalt God? What would that look like in your life?



Day 5

Psalms 106:1

"Praise the LORD. Give thanks to the LORD, for He is good; His love endures forever."

Does God's love ever run out? Why are you thankful for that?



Day 6

Psalms 100:4

"Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His courts with praise; give thanks to Him and praise His name."

Why do you think God loves it when we praise and thank Him?



Day 7

Psalms 95:2

"Let us come before Him with thanksgiving and extol Him with music and song."

Why do you think God loves it when we sing to Him? Is it just the music that He loves, or the way our heart attitude is before Him?



Day 8

Psalms 69:30

"I will praise God's name in song and glorify Him with thanksgiving."

How do we glorify God?



Day 9

Psalms 28:7

"The Lord is my strength and my shield; my heart trusts in Him, and I am helped. My heart leaps for joy and I will give thanks to Him in song."

What is one way God has helped you today?



Day 10

Psalms 7:17

"I will give to the Lord the thanks due to His righteousness, and I will sing praise to the name of the Lord, the Most High."

It says God is "due" our thanksgiving. What does that mean?



Day 11

Psalm 9:1

"I will give thanks to the LORD with my whole heart; I will recount all of your wonderful deeds."

Can we only praise God with part of our hearts? Why is important to praise Him with our whole heart?



Day 12

Psalm 26:7

"Proclaiming thanksgiving aloud, and telling all your wondrous deeds."

It says to proclaim thanksgiving out loud! Let's do that right now. Let's tell God all about His wondrous deeds!



Day 13

Psalm 30:4

"Sing praises to the LORD, O you His saints, and give thanks to His holy name."

God's name is Holy. What does that mean?



Day 14

Psalm 44:8

"In God we have boasted continually, and we will give thanks to your name forever. Selah."

It's not good to be boastful [proud] but it is good to boast in one thing alone. What is that?



Day 15

Psalm 57:9

"I will give thanks to you, O Lord, among the peoples; I will sing praises to you among the nations."

How can you praise God around the people in your life? What about praising Him among the nations? How can you do that?



Day 16

Psalm 136:2

"Give thanks to the God of gods, for His steadfast love endures forever."

The verse says His love is steadfast. What does that mean?



Day 17

Isaiah 12:4

"And you will say in that day: give thanks to the LORD, call upon His name, make known His deeds among the peoples, proclaim that His name is exalted."

How do we call upon God's name?



Day 18

Matthew 15:36

"He took the seven loaves and the fish, and having given thanks He broke them and gave them to the disciples, and the disciples gave them to the crowds."

Who is our ultimate example of giving thanks here in this verse?



Day 19

Luke 2:38

"And coming up at that very hour she began to give thanks to God and to speak of Him to all who were waiting for the redemption of Jerusalem."

This passage is talking about the prophetess Anna. How did she show others she loved God?



Day 20

Luke 17:16

"And he fell on his face at Jesus' feet, giving Him thanks. Now he was a Samaritan."

In what way did the Samaritan show he loved Jesus here? How can our hearts follow his example?



Day 21

Romans 1:21

"For although they knew God, they did not honor Him as God or give thanks to Him, but they became futile in their thinking, and their foolish hearts were darkened."

How can we be careful to honor God and give thanks to Him daily so our hearts won't become darkened?



Day 22

1 Corinthians 1:4

"I give thanks to my God always for you because of the grace of God that was give you in Christ Jesus."

We can thank God and give thanks because of what gift that we have been given through Jesus Christ?



Day 23

1 Corinthians 15:57

"But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ."

Who is our victory found in?



Day 24

2 Corinthians 1:11

"You also must help us by prayer, so that many will give thanks on our behalf for the blessing granted us through the prayers of many."

Why is prayer an important part of thanksgiving? How does it affect not only you, but others?



Day 25

2 Corinthians 2:14

"But thanks be to God, who in Christ always leads us in triumphal procession, and through us spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of Him everywhere."

What does triumph mean? Who allows us to triumph and gives us strength?

2 Corinthians 4:15

"For it is all for your sake, so that as grace extends to more and more people it may increase thanksgiving, to the glory of God."

What are some of the benefits of showing grace to other people?



Day 27

Ephesians 5:20

"Giving thanks always and for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ."

Are we only supposed to thank God sometimes?

Philippians 4:6

"Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God."
