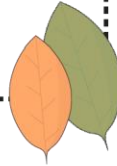


This Month's Learning & Activities

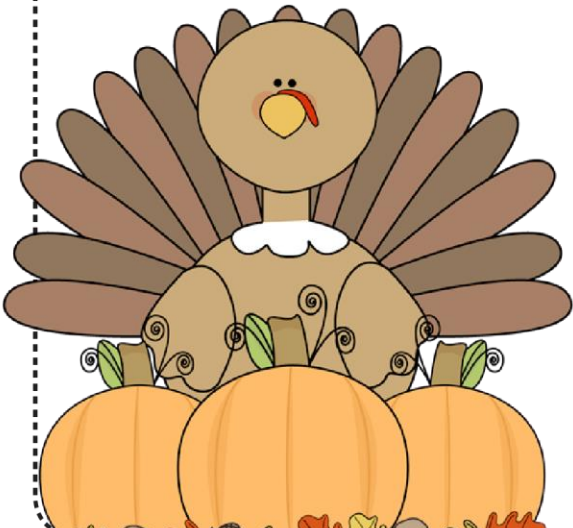

* We will have a sign up for food and volunteers as we get closer to this special time

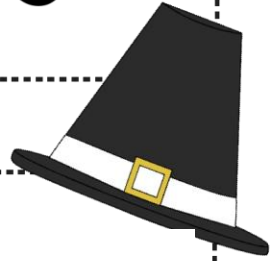


Notes, Reminders & Tips
