Reminders:

- Please label all your child's things. This includes bed sheets, binkys, bottles, bibs, etc.
- If your child has started to walk or has started to troll around the room, please bring in shoes for them to practice with. This will be helpful for the next classroom as the Yearling Room requires to have shoes on.
- We cannot give breastmilk bottles/bags to anyone unless they are labeled.
- Please label everything that goes into the fridge.
- Please bring home breastmilk bags every night. This is to avoid if your child is unexpectedly sick/absent the next day and they wouldn't have milk at school.
- Please always have a bathing suit and towel if you would like to have your child go out for water play and please **apply sunscreen before drop off**.
- Please use your child's assigned bins and cubbies to leave things here for the week. It is okay to stock up on foods or bibs for the week. It is also okay to leave things like shoes or jackets here. Just make sure they have your child's initials or name on them. ☺
