Thank you for all you have done!

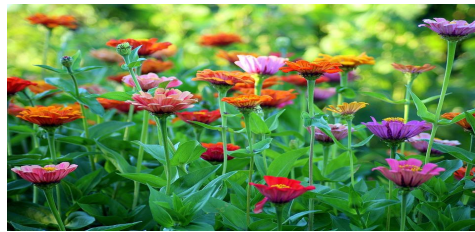
