### **Infant Reminders**

- ✚ **We will be starting our summer program on Monday June 21<sup>st</sup>**
- ✚ Please sunblock your child (6mo and older) in the morning before school. Use your best judgment: even cloudy days bring about sunburns, but if the forecast calls for rainy weather, then no sunblock needed. It is better to be on the safe side, but we do not want the kids sitting in sunblock unnecessarily either. We will re-apply for the afternoon.
- ✚ New England has crazy weather! Cold in the morning, warm in the late morning, breezy in the afternoon - please try and pack a range of items. Items that can be layered are best, such as a short-sleeved onesie/shirt with a long-sleeved light sweater.
- ✚ Please label everything that you bring in for your child. Crib sheets are easily confused when there is no name. Bottles, cups, lunch bags, and snacks that need to be refrigerated should also have a name. Thank you!
